



Barbara Schneiderman Memorial Fund for Piano Enrichment Scholarship Selection Criteria and Application Process

General Criteria

Selection will be made without regard for race, color, national origin, age or sex of candidate. No members of the families of the Scholarship Committee, or employees of the Foundation, shall be eligible for any scholarship.

The Foundation will not be under obligation to distribute funds if no suitable candidates are found in a given period of time. Neither the Scholarship Committee nor the Foundation shall be liable for the acts, neglects or defaults of any person employed by the Committee or by the Foundation selected with reasonable care, or for any error in judgment, or any act done or steps taken or omitted upon the advice of counsel, for any mistakes of facts or of law, or for anything the Committee or Foundation may do or refrain from doing in good faith.

Suzuki Scholarship Award

1. Scholarships will be awarded to students who are studying Suzuki music (piano only).
2. Awards will be applied to tuition for the San Diego Suzuki Institute Summer Program.
3. The scholarship is open to elementary, middle and high school students in San Diego County.

Application Process

- ✓ Complete all sections of the application.
- ✓ Submit a letter of recommendation from a current or former music teacher.
- ✓ Make sure the application is signed by a parent or guardian.
- ✓ **Applications must be received electronically by May 17, 2019.**

If awarded a scholarship, the check will be sent directly to the San Diego Suzuki Institute to be applied toward the student's program fee.
