After he passed away in February 2016, McNeil's family, friends, and colleagues wanted to honor him by making a difference in the lives of students, specifically those pursuing a degree in finance. Established by Stratos Wealth Partners and Ibis Capital, McNeil's former employers, the Neal McNeil III Memorial Fund provides resources for scholarships.

The Neal McNeil III Memorial Scholarship is a fund of the Coastal Community Foundation (CCF). The Foundation is a nonprofit corporation created in 1987 by residents of North Coastal San Diego County. The mission of CCF is to enhance the quality of life in the San Diego North County area by directing philanthropic efforts toward community needs.

Scholarship Amount: **\$2,000**

Scholarship Criteria

1. Scholarship will be awarded to a college student who is pursuing a career in finance.
2. Student must be a sophomore or junior at California State University San Marcos or San Diego State University at time of application.
3. Scholarship is merit based.
4. Minimum GPA 3.0

Selection will be made without regard for race, color, national origin, age or gender of the candidate. No members of the families of the Scholarship Committee, or employees of the Foundation, shall be eligible for any scholarship.
