



EdVentures 2022-23 Grant Application Guidelines and Instructions

Grant Eligibility and Guidelines

EdVentures is a grant program of the Coastal Community Foundation that supports hand-on, creative educational experiences for students in North San Diego County schools with an emphasis on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art/Music and Math) curriculum.

The *EdVentures* grant program will provide funding to nonprofit organizations for STEAM programs that are held on-site at elementary and middle schools or for educational experiences/field trips provided by nonprofits.

- ◆ Projects must serve **4th-8th grade students** in North San Diego County Public Schools in one or more of the following districts: Carlsbad, Cardiff, Del Mar, Encinitas, Escondido, Oceanside, San Marcos, Solana Beach, or Vista.
- ◆ Projects must align with school district curricular goals and standards.
- ◆ Nonprofits that provide educational programs in San Diego County may apply.
- ◆ Grant range is \$3,000 to \$10,000.
- ◆ Grant funding will not fund bus transportation for field trips, general operations, or capital items.

- You may also submit a letter of endorsement from a teacher, principal or district administrator. Send to: grants@coastalfoundation.org
- Only one application may be submitted per nonprofit.

The application deadline is October 3, 2022. Applications received past the deadline will not be considered. *If you are awarded a grant, the check will be made payable to your nonprofit and designated for the specific classroom project at selected schools or districts. Funding must be used for projects during the 2022-23 academic year. A brief report on the expenditure of funds will be required, including the list of schools and number of students served.*
